We need lots and lots of volunteers (for set up, working the event, and clean up)

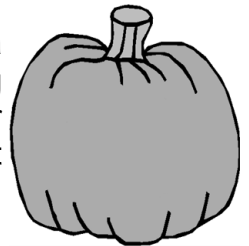
We need lots and lots of candy donations (put it in the bin in the foyer)
